



COVID SAFE PLAN

To meet requirements of Occupational Health and Safety legislation and to fulfil the Common Law Duty of Care owed to its patrons, Brighton Theatre Company has in place a comprehensive **Covid Safe Plan**.

Company policy requires all directors, actors, members of production teams and other volunteers as well as patrons attending any performance to observe all aspects of this plan.

The principal components of the plan designed to offer maximum protection and reduced risk of virus transmission are:

Required Covid19 vaccination status.

- “Fully Vaccinated” now means for all persons aged 12 years and over, having had **three** vaccine injections administered
- For each performance, a Covid Marshal will be in attendance to ensure that all patrons comply with this requirement
- Surveillance provided by the Marshal will be in addition to registering attendance using a QR code.

Observation of personal hygiene and use of personal protection

- Hand sanitiser stations will be placed at each entrance to the foyer and auditorium and their use by patrons encouraged by front of house personnel
- Masks are to be always worn inside the building and retained whilst seated in the auditorium

Environmental controls including provision for social distancing

- Ventilation of the theatre auditorium has been upgraded so that air exchange and purification comply with current public health standards
- Social distance of 2 sq m per person shall be observed in seating plans
- Refreshment will no longer be provided at interval or after a performance. All patrons will be encouraged by front of house personnel to leave the building as quickly as possible
